The ground of this appeal is that the three individuals do not qualify to contest the said primaries within the meaning of Article 12 (4) and (7) of the NPP Constitution.

It appears that **SAMUEL BINFOH DARKWA**, belongs to the group of people who never associate themselves with the Adansi Asokwa N.P.P., and never contribute anything to the constituency party but only show up when there are parliamentary primaries.

I was the substantive secretary at the time of last election. **SAMUEL BINFOH DARKWA** has never been part of any constituency activity and has never made any contribution to the constituency party that I know of in the various capacities I have indicated.

Indeed, we understand that, during the last election, he contested primaries in the lower Akyim Constituency in the Eastern Region, far away from Adansi Asokwa. He appears to be roving aspirant.
